SUTRON CORPORATION BOOKS \$1,929,292 IN AUGUST

September 6, 2005, Sterling, VA..... Sutron Corporation (OTC BB: STRN.OB), America's leader in remote hydro-met monitoring, announced today that during August 2005 the company received orders and contracts totaling \$1,929,292 to provide services, equipment and systems for a variety of water and weather monitoring projects throughout the world.

NOAA's National Ocean Service (NOS) gave Sutron a purchase order for \$948,407 for Sutron's NOS-approved Tide Stations that monitor and warn of coastal phenomena such as storm surge and tsunami.

The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) awarded to Sutron additional service contracts totaling \$295,975. Sutron's Florida offices provide SFWMD with flow monitoring, science and engineering, site installation and SCADA services in support of SFWMD's compliance with requirements of CERP (Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan).

The Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) contracted with Sutron to provide precipitation and water level station equipment valued at \$126,775. This order is the first of those covered by an agreement between LCRA and Sutron to purchase up to \$500,000 in equipment and services over the next three years for LCRA's Hydromet Expansion Project.

During August, Sutron also received orders from the US Bureau of Reclamation, the US Geological Survey, the US Army Corps of Engineers, and international orders from the nations of China, Norway, Trinidad Tobago and Poland.
