Sutron Corporation Announces July Bookings of \$1,705,068 for World-wide Projects

STERLING, VA—August 3, 2005 -- During July 2005, Sutron Corporation (OTC BB:[STRN.OB](#)) received orders and contracts totaling \$1,705,068 to provide services, equipment, systems and software for a variety of water and weather monitoring projects throughout the world.

Sutron received a purchase order for \$423,930 from the USGS Hydrologic Instrumentation Facility (HIF) for Sutron Accububble Systems, XLite Dataloggers and 115 units of Sutron's SatLink2 GOES Transmitter/Logger, the first GOES Satellite Transmitter/Logger with Pocket PC communications, 4 analog inputs and 10 SDI-12 interfaces.

The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) awarded additional service contracts totaling \$319,288 to Sutron's Brandon, Florida office. Sutron provides the District with flow monitoring, science and engineering, site installation and SCADA services in support of SFWMD's actions to comply with requirements of CERP (Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan).

A contract totaling \$284,554 was received from the AlfaCom, S.A. located in Honduras to supply automatic precipitation and water level stations to the Government of Honduras for the Natural Disasters Mitigation Project. This equipment will be integrated with the current network of automatic stations to support the National Hydrological Forecast Center, an integral part of the decision making for flood alerts.

Other significant orders received in July included an order for \$121,132 from NOAA's National Ocean Service (NOS) for NOS Hydrographic Gauges, an order for \$82,500 under the Company's five year agreement with Beijing Shinetek for SatLink2 Loggers/Transmitters and an order for \$41,500 from the French National Scientific Research Center for SatLink2 stations to be installed in four African countries.
