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SUTRON'S SEPTEMBER BOOKINGS TOP \$2,929,628

October 2, 2008, Sterling, VA... Sutron Corporation (NASDAQ: STRN), a leading provider of hydrological, meteorological and oceanic monitoring products, systems and services, today announced that during September 2008 the company received bookings (purchase orders and contracts) totaling \$2,929,628 to provide equipment, systems and services for a variety of water and weather monitoring, control and warning projects throughout the world.

* NOAA NOS awarded Sutron a multi-year contract to provide Maintenance Services for NOS Tide Stations along the East Coast. The contract is currently only funded in the amount of \$15,000 but 2009 funding in the amount of \$311,176 is anticipated. Additional funding is anticipated for 2010 and 2011 in the amounts of \$260,296 and 269,080, respectively. If fully funded, the three year contract would total \$840,552.

Sutron's cumulative bookings for the 3rd quarter of 2008 equaled \$5,504,650.
