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## SUTRON CORPORATION BOOKS \$2,064,582 APRIL 2006

May 7, 2006, Sterling, VA... Sutron Corporation (NASDAQ: STRN), a leading provider of hydrological, meteorological, and oceanic monitoring products, systems and services, is pleased to announce the receipt of orders totaling \$2,064,582 in April, 2006. The following orders were the most significant:

- (1) A \$705,887 order from Prime Controls to install monitoring stations in New Orleans on three primary water control canals for the US Army Corps of Engineers. Reliable real-time monitoring of these canals is vital for managing risk during the up-coming 2006 hurricane season, beginning in one month. Sutron plays a key role in securing this critical New Orleans infrastructure by providing monitoring, warning and control expertise, systems and services.
- (2) Three orders equaling \$603,939 from the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) for supplemental engineering services.
- (3) A \$336,470 order from the US Geological Survey's HIF for Sutron's GOES Satellite Transmitter/Logger, SatLink2, and various sensors for measuring water level. This order is primarily to replace equipment damaged as a result of Hurricane Katrina in Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana and Texas.
- (4) A \$210,978 order from Global Elite, Sutron's agent in Panama, to provide weather and water monitoring equipment to ETESA (Empresa de Trasmisión Eléctrica ), the company responsible for production and distribution of electric power in Panama.

Sutron Corporation's total bookings for the first four months of this year are \$5,910,356.

Sutron designs, manufactures, installs and supports system solutions for hydrological, meteorological, and coastal/oceanic systems monitoring water level, water quality, flooding, coastline and tidal parameters, weather, dam safety and hydropower. Sutron's customers include Federal Agencies such as the US Geological Survey, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the Army Corps of Engineers, and the National Weather Service.
